FORT BEND ISD POLICE DEPARTMENTIncident Narrative:**Supplement #2 - Added on: Thursday, April 26, 2007 by 1825**

Reporting officer M. Harvey, a Ft. Bend ISD Police Detective assisted Officer J. B. Holmes at Clements High School with potential threats made to that school on a website created by a student, Paul Hwang, [REDACTED]. Reporting officer assisted Cpl. Holmes in a "Consent to Search" at the students residence after his parents arrived. The officers found five "ornamental" or decorative knives of varying lengths. Though the knives appeared to be ornamental or ceremonial knives, if used in an inappropriate way they could be deadly weapons. In addition, if discovered outside the home by a police officer the knives were of sufficient length that they could be considered a prohibited weapon. Hwang shut down his website in the officer's presence. His parents were very surprised that Hwang had these knives in his possession in his room. While the officers were there Hwang's parent chastised him for having the weapons and promised they would take control of them.

Cpl. Holmes made contact with the Ft. Bend County District Attorney's Office to have it review this case. (See Disposition).
